Please Note:

The balance is due by June 18, 2010 along with your child's medical form and consent waiver.

Refunds & Policies:

Camp fees are non-refundable and non-transferable. In the event of a medical cancellation, \$10.00 of your deposit will be a registration fee. There is a \$20.00 charge for any non-sufficient checks. There is no pro-rated fee for campers arriving after the start of the session or leaving before its completion. There is a \$10.00 fee for any change after registration. The Camp is not responsible for loss or damage to any camper's property during riding lessons.

Arrival & Departures:

The entrance to the Double H Ranch is located on Hiram Trail approximately ¼ mile east of Lander Road. DO NOT DROP CHILDREN OFF AT THE CAMP'S MAIN PARKING LOT. Lessons will begin promptly at the assigned time. On the first day of camp, campers will meet outside of riding arena. Campers should be picked up 3 hours after class begins. If your camper cannot attend a lesson, please call the camp office at (216) 831-5045.

Riding & Climbing Wall Apparel:

Campers are required to wear boots or shoes with one-inch heels and long pants. Campers arriving in shorts and/or sneakers will not be able to participate. Approved helmets are provided. To participate on the climbing wall campers will have to have socks and tennis shoes.

Helpful Reminders/Hints:

Please do not send your child in new clothes, they are uncomfortable!

If you would like your camper protected by sunscreen or bug spray please apply before you leave home.

Campers are not permitted to bring treats for their horse without instructors permission.
